INDIA STACK – INSPIRING THE WORLD

- India Stack: cost-effective technological solutions on a population scale has captivated the world's attention
- Open-source components facilitate other countries to speed up their digital infrastructure journeys
- Armenia, Sierra Leone, Suriname, Antigua, Barbuda, Trinidad and Tobago have partnered to implement India Stack, for enhancing their digital infrastructure.
- Adoption of cutting-edge digital infrastructure can trigger global transformation



INDIA'S ECONOMIC TRANSFORMATION



- Fastest-growing major economy
- 10th largest economy to 5th largest economy in the world in last 9 years
- Preferred investment destination worldwide – highest-ever FDI of \$83 billion in 2021-22
- Overall export was US\$ 776.3 billion in 2022-23 which is the highest ever
- 3rd largest startup ecosystem with 1 lakh+ startups and 110+ unicorns

INDIA: THRIVING HUB OF TECH AND INNOVATION



- Indian IT companies have become global giants and technology startup ecosystem has witnessed remarkable growth
- "Make in India" and "Digital India" have encouraged entrepreneurship and foreign investment
- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has made impressive strides in satellite technology and space missions, notably with the Mangalyaan and Chandrayaan-3 missions.
- Gaganyaan Programme to mark India's foray into the new age of human space exploration

INDIA: FROM REGIONAL POWER TO GLOBAL PLAYER



- India's foreign policy is now stronger, bolder, and more autonomous
- India now recognised as a significant player in global affairs
- India now takes a more dynamic and action-oriented approach in advancing its interests
- India resisted external pressures, asserting its strategic independence
- India skillfully navigated international politics, maintaining a balanced approach with major powers
- India displayed mature and humanitarian diplomacy, providing critical medicines and vaccines during the COVID pandemic
- Indian soft power like Yoga, Spirituality, Bollywood and Millets are now making a mark in the global stage

'INDIA FIRST' AT ALL COSTS

- India walked out of the RCEP, the world's largest trade deal because of minimal benefits
- Despite Western concerns, India fostered relations with Iran and Russia
- Resisted Western pressure to cut Russian oil imports
- Now firm actions instead of passively accepting aggression from Pakistan and China
- Government initiatives like PLI and Make in India reduce reliance on Chinese imports
- Poised to be a major player in the global supply chain



SETTING THE NARRATIVE GLOBALLY



- India; a key player in global mechanisms like G20, QUAD, BRICS and SCO
- India's ban on Chinese apps and increased focus on the One Belt One Road Initiative is gaining global attention
- Promotes international law, sovereignty, and a rules-based global order.
- Global campaign against terrorism, money laundering, black money and illicit incomes yielding results
- India's G20 leadership effective in reforming multilateral development banks, and addressing debt concerns in vulnerable countries

INDIA'S BOLD CHINA POLICY

- Accelerated its military modernization and infrastructure development along the border with China
- A more assertive stance in addressing border disputes with China
- Indian forces intervened to prevent Chinese road construction in disputed region
- Implemented economic measures to reduce its dependence on China
- Participation in the QUAD is seen as part of a particular focus on countering China's assertiveness



'NEIGHBOURHOOD FIRST' AND 'ACT EAST' POLICY

- **'Neighbourhood First'** policy strengthened ties with India's neighbours
- Initiatives like SAARC satellite, and joint military exercises underscore India's commitment to regional growth stability
- Projects like the INSTC, IMEC, India-Myanmar-Thailand Trilateral Highway, and Chabahar Port boost regional trade and connectivity



- PM Modi rebranded the Look East Policy as the **'Act East Policy'**
- India enhanced connectivity, trade, and defense collaborations with Vietnam, Indonesia, Bangladesh, and the Philippines
- India championed SAGAR (Security and Growth for All), a regional framework based on collective security and economic well-being

PROMINENCE WITHIN THE GLOBAL SOUTH

- India has strengthened its diplomatic and trade ties in the Global South
- India has expanded its development aid, offering grants, credit lines, and technical support to Global South nations
- During its G20 presidency, India championed the interests of the Global South
- Achieved a major milestone by securing the African Union's membership in the G20.

GLOBAL PANDEMIC RESPONSE – HELPING THE WORLD IN CRISIS

- Self-reliance in healthcare, emerging "pharmacy of the world"
- World's largest vaccination drive- with **220 crore** COVID vaccine doses administered
- Vaccine Maitri initiative-India supplied **30 crore+** vaccine doses to 100+ countries
- Extended humanitarian aid- to **82 nations** by providing test kits and protective gear worth Rs. **100 crore**
- Covid-related training for healthcare professionals in SAARC countries
- Technical assistance by dispatching Rapid Response Teams to countries like Comoros, Mauritius, Kuwait and Maldives



LEADING FROM THE FRONT IN CLIMATE ACTION

- India met the target of 40% power generation from non-fossil sources **9 years** before target
- Ambitious target of **500 GW** renewable energy capacity by 2030, net zero by 2070
- India's solar energy capacity has grown by **2500%** since 2014
- India-led Initiatives like International Solar Alliance (ISA), Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure (CDRI), and Global Biofuel Alliance (GBA) have attracted several countries
- Mantra of LiFE – Lifestyle For Environment – given to the world



OFFERING A HELPING HAND TO PEOPLE IN DISTRESS

- Vande Bharat Mission: **3.2 crore** stranded Indians brought home during the pandemic

- Operation Raahat: **6,710 people** evacuated from Yemen

- Operation Ganga: Around 22,500 Indians evacuated from Ukraine earthquake rescue operation

India showcased its remarkable capability in evacuating citizens and foreigners from natural disasters and strife-torn areas:

- Operation Maitri: Around **5000 Indians** evacuated from Nepal
- Operation Kaveri: Around **4000 Indians** evacuated from Sudan
- Operation Dost: 4 teams with **3.8 tons** of Disaster Relief Material and deployed in Turkey
- Operation Ajay: Around **1186 Indians** evacuated from Israel as on Oct 19.

- PM Modi showcases India's charm through visits to Kashi, Ayodhya, Mahabalipuram, and Amritsar with world leaders.
- Promotes Indian craftsmanship with gifts from local artisans and emphasizes visits to religious sites globally.
- 12 additional sites entered the UNESCO World Heritage list.
- The UN recognizes June 21 as International Yoga Day, highlighting India's cultural heritage.
- During India's G20 presidency, over 220 meetings in 60 cities highlighted India's diverse culture and multi-sectoral growth.


THE YEAR 2023 – THIS IS INDIA'S TIME

G20 DELHI DECLARATION: NATIONS SPEAK IN ONE VOICE




India effectively addressed global challenges and fostered enhanced cooperation
